
1 Boynton Canyon

All right, Zoosh here.

Welcome.

Boynton Canyon has been visited most frequently by ships from Sirius and Orion, and contacts with those vehicles happened, in terms of frequency, mostly before 1900. It was so common before 1900 that people who passed through the area—and there were also some people who stayed there for a while, going back in time—would see them so often that it used to be like, "Oh, there they are again," not unlike the attitude some high-mountain communities have in other countries, "Oh, there they are again; isn't that nice."


So the Sirians and the Orions at that time were getting along pretty well, because it's not unusual for



ET civilizations to get along. And you might reasonably ask, "Well, why did they go there?" They did because for a long time, there was an underground base there that accommodated both groups. The base is no longer there, no longer in use, but it accommodated both groups from about A.D. 1400 to 1900, with a few occasional visits after. There was an underground base there that was thoroughly occupied; there was a lot of energy transfer going on between Superstition Mountain in the south, Boynton Canyon and, going up to the north, Mount Rainier in Washington State.

And the linkup was energetic. It was designed—and this is interesting—to help souls who would come to the area in 1900 and beyond, souls who would have that focus of either Sirius or Orion in their soul energy and come to that place and be replenished by the energy. Very often ETs, when they visit a planet, will do so for service reasons—to provide energy and benefit to those who either are there or will follow at some time in the future. It is typical to find ETs involved in various services like this all over the place.

Now, that energy they built up, the link between that high mountain in Washington State and Super-



stition Mountain in Arizona, that energy is still available there and is providing an interesting side benefit: From time to time, though it is uncommon there now, the energy from Boynton Canyon has largely flowed into Sycamore Canyon, which I think is a little bit more in the general direction of Cottonwood. That energy that was in Boynton Canyon has flowed down there, and the side benefit to this happening is that there are ships that come to that place but don't land. They're still seen—they don't land—because the energy that is still broadcast in that general area tends to attract those vehicles. This is a side benefit for those who like to see ships.

It's like a transmitter, an unintentional transmitter that has not been shut off, because the purpose was to support and sustain and nurture souls who might have had a focus, in a given life, through Sirius or Orion. Now, people refer to this focus in other ways. They say, "Oh, where are you from?" and then they say their star heritage, meaning their soul, "I'm a soul from this place," or "I'm from that place," but from my point of view, it has to do with the soul focus. There hasn't been much other influence in that area, just those particular beings.
